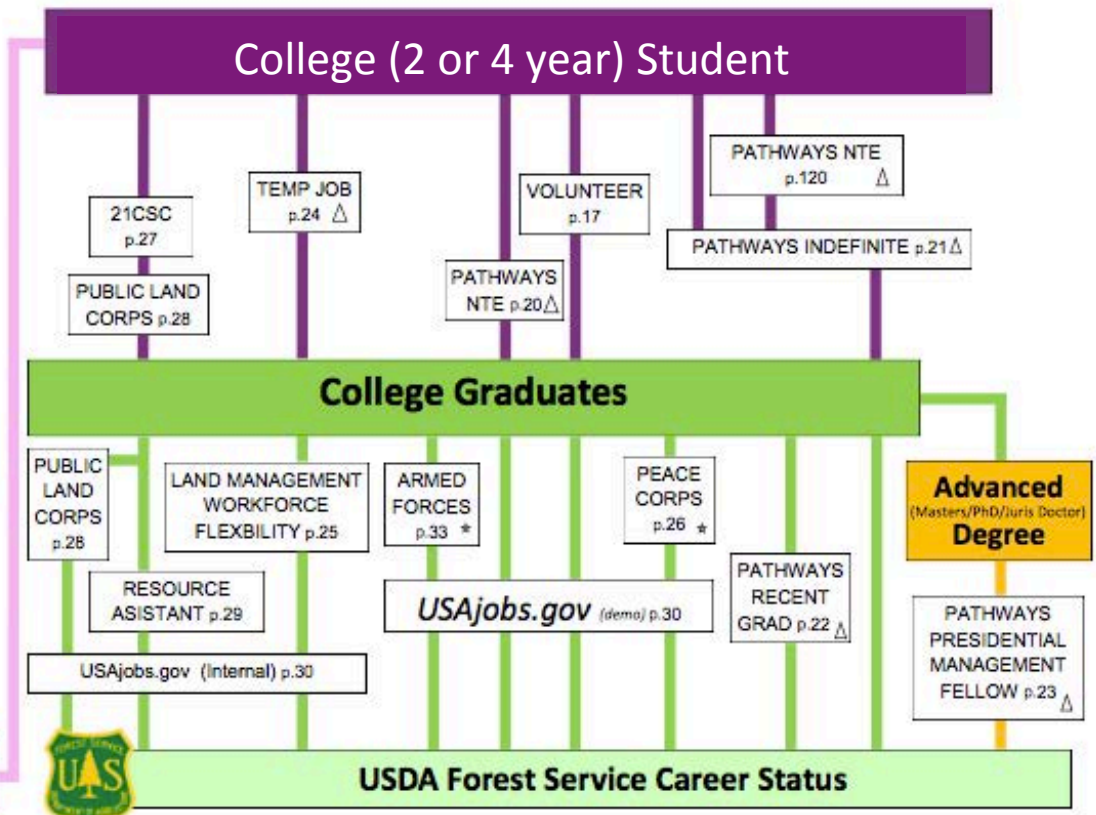
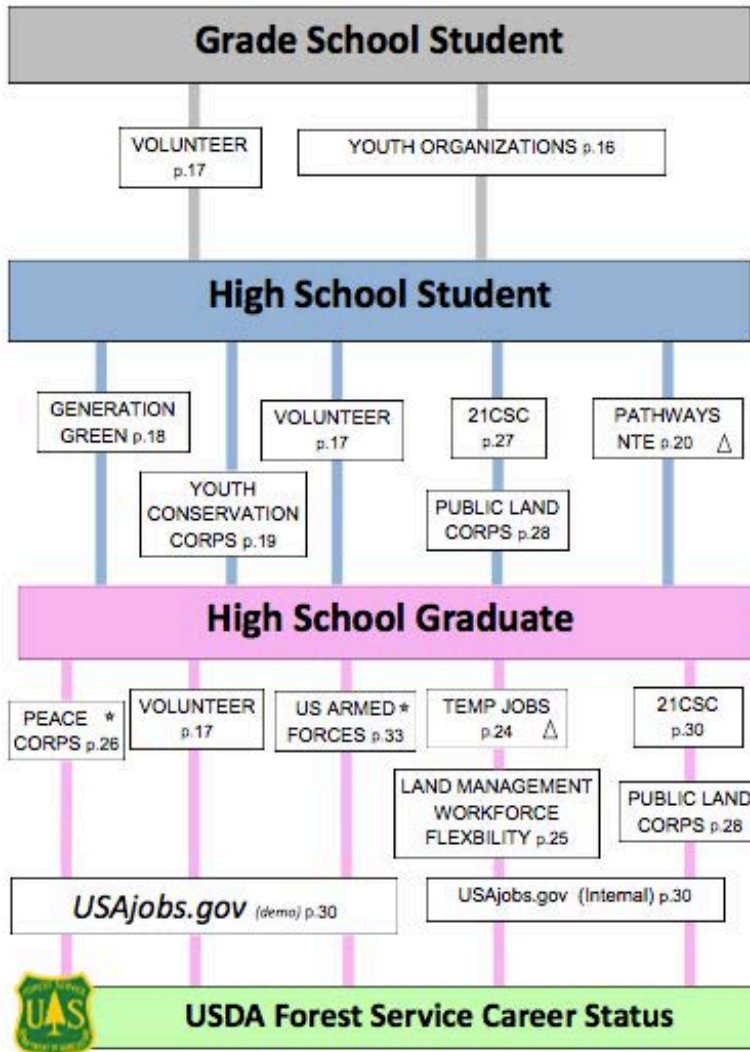

# Career Corridors



## Student-Focused Career Corridors

**KEY** △ Must apply through USAjobs.gov to participate in this program. \* May receive additional preference when applying to USAjobs.gov.

- The Grey corridors lead to available opportunities during Grade School.
- The Blue corridors lead to available opportunities during High School.
- The Pink corridors lead to available opportunities when a student graduates from High School; including going to a 2 or 4 year College.
- The Purple corridors lead to available opportunities during College.
- Green corridors connect Purple corridors to available opportunities after College graduation. Green corridors that lead directly to "USDA Forest Service Career Status" will be converted into a career status (i.e. Pathways Indefinite and Pathways Recent Grad).
- The Orange corridor leads to "Pathways Presidential Management Fellow," which leads directly to "USDA Forest Career Status."
